**Mick Jordan** is currently a Senior Staff Engineer and Principal Investigator at Sun Microsystems Laboratories. His interests include programming languages, programming environments, software configuration management, and persistent object systems. He has a Ph.D. in Computer Science from the University of Cambridge, UK.

**Malcolm Atkinson** is a Visiting Professor at Sun Microsystems Laboratories, and has been a Professor at the University of Glasgow since 1984. He has sought to provide better persistence to programmers since working in a CAD and graphics group in Cambridge with Mick Jordan in the early 1970s. He identified the value of orthogonal persistence at VLDB'78, and led a team that built the first orthogonally-persistent language, PS-algol, in 1980. Since then, he has worked on improving the implementation, semantics, and programming practices for both persistence and object-oriented systems.
